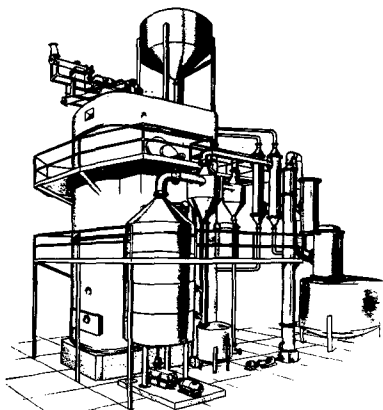

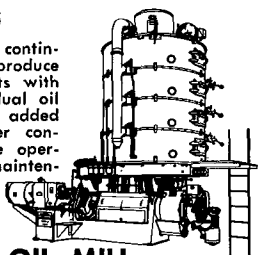

Needed: 400 More Proxies

A THIRD REQUEST for proxies from the active membership was made in January by the Governing Board of the American Oil Chemists' Society in regard to the proposed changes in the constitution and by-laws. The Board has asked for approval of the changes, which are intended to make possible more flexibility in the setting of fees, establish an active junior membership classification, set up a policy for deciding a tie vote for any office, make certain changes in procedure for the Referee Examining Board, and bring the amendment on meetings of the Society into agreement with actual practice. Changes in the by-laws are needed to implement the amendments to the constitution.

A favorable vote of two-thirds of the active membership of the Society, present in person or by proxy, at the annual meeting in New Orleans, April 29-May 1, 1957, is required for adoption.

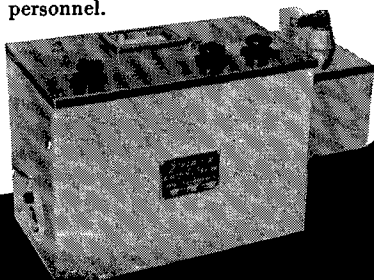
