The meeting will be held in the Statler Hilton hotel, with "Saludos Amigos" as the theme. The Golden State room and the Los Angeles room have been chosen for the technical sessions. Exhibits will be displayed in the Garden room overlooking the pool and garden below. About half of the available space has already been reserved.

The technical program will deal with soaps, detergents, fish oils, polyunsaturated fatty acids, polymerized oils, edible and inedible oils, shortenings, and so on. Abstracts should be about 200 words in length and should be submitted in triplicate by June 15.

Field tours will be arranged with local industry. The ladies will have a trip to Hollywood and the TV and movie studios, with fashion shows, teas, and luncheon besides.

Bond Award Given to ERRL Ms.

Winners of the Bond award for the best paper of the year were Joseph E. Coleman and Daniel Swern of Eastern Regional Research Laboratory, U.S.D.A., Philadelphia, for their paper entitled "Oxidation of Olefins with Potassium Permanganate in Oil/Water Emulsion," which was presented at the 1958 fall meeting of the American Oil Chemists' Society in Chicago and published in the December issue of the *Journal of the A.O.C.S.*

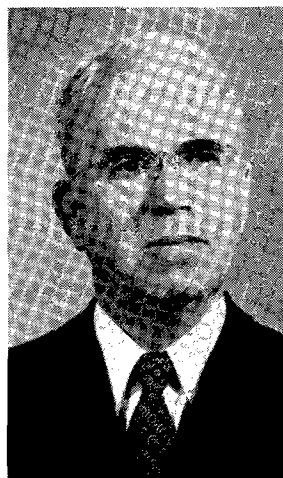
Presentation was made at the 50th anniversary meeting of the Society in New Orleans at the Roosevelt hotel on April 20.

The award is a gold medal for the person delivering the paper and a certificate to co-authors. Oral presentation is given 60 points, and preparation of the manuscript 40 points. The purpose is to stimulate interest in presenting papers before the Society and in improving the over-all quality of the presentation and the manuscript.

For 1959 the judges will consider papers given at the New Orleans meeting in April and the September 28-30 meeting in Los Angeles. The award will be bestowed at the Dallas spring meeting in 1960.

The organization committee for the Bond award, which has been established by an anonymous donor, has comprised A. R. Baldwin, Cargill Inc., Minneapolis, as chairman; W. O. Lundberg, Hormel Institute, Austin, Minn.; and D. H. Wheeler, General Mills Inc., Minneapolis.
