R.A. Decker (1947), Methods Research, Central Quality Control, Armour and Company, Chicago, died suddenly in July. He was a member of three Society committees.

M.L. Degavre (1929), Emeritus Member, died recently in Louisville, Ky. When a chemist for the Colgate-Palmolive Company, he served as chairman of the A.O.C.S. Louisville section and of regional meetings in the 1930's.

J.T.R. Andrews

J.T.R. Andrews (1930), Emeritus Member of the Society, and retired Procter and Gamble chemist, died of a heart attack on July 20, 1961. Mr. Andrews, who retired in 1959, was 67 and lived in Jackson Center, Ohio, where he had recently moved in order to be near his favorite trailer spot on Indian Lake.

Throughout his technical career Mr. Andrews devoted much time to the American Oil Chemists' Society. For many years he was chairman of the Glycerine Analysis Committee and the Uniform Methods Committee. Along with these assignments Andy found time to serve on the Governing Board, the Membership Committee, and the Journal Editorial Board. He was always a staunch supporter of the Society and its ideals, and twice was a candidate for the presidency.

J.T.R. Andrews was an analytical chemist. He made an important contribution to the A.O.C.S. Methods and to the analytical literature of many technical journals. His work with Procter and Gamble was devoted to methods investigation, special analyses, and finally to factory technical service. He was a man with strong ideals and a friend of everyone.
