

17th Pittsburgh Conference Invites Analytical, Spectroscopy Papers

The seventeenth Pittsburgh Conference on Analytical Chemistry and Applied Spectroscopy, Inc., sponsored by the Analytical Chemistry Group of the Pittsburgh Section of the American Chemical Society and the Spectroscopy Society of Pittsburgh, will be held at the Penn-Sheraton Hotel in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, February 21-25, 1966.

Twelve Symposia Scheduled

The following symposia are now being arranged: 1) Combined Gas Chromatographic-Mass Spectrometric Techniques; 2) Fast Reaction Kinetics; 3) Electron Spin Resonance; 4) Electron Microprobe; 5) Process Control X-ray Spectrometry; 6) Atomic Absorption; 7) Coblenz Society Symposium; 8) Gas Chromatography Utilizing Pyrolytic Techniques; 9) NMR Spectra of Polymeric Materials; 10) Nuclear Magnetic Double Resonance; 11) Magnetic Optical Rotatory Dispersion; 12) New Instrumentation Techniques.

Original papers on all phases of analytical chemistry and spectroscopy are invited. All papers will be evaluated by the Program Committee before acceptance. Authors planning to submit papers should follow the requirements in the attached "Regulations Governing Papers." The final date for receipt of abstracts is October 1, 1965.

This year the Exposition of Modern Laboratory Equipment will include more than 175 exhibitors. The Exposition provides both an opportunity to see the latest equipment in the analytical and spectroscopic fields and also to discuss this equipment with the manufacturers.

A program of activities for the wives and lady attendees of the Conference is also being arranged.

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Applied Spectroscopy Meeting Set for Chicago

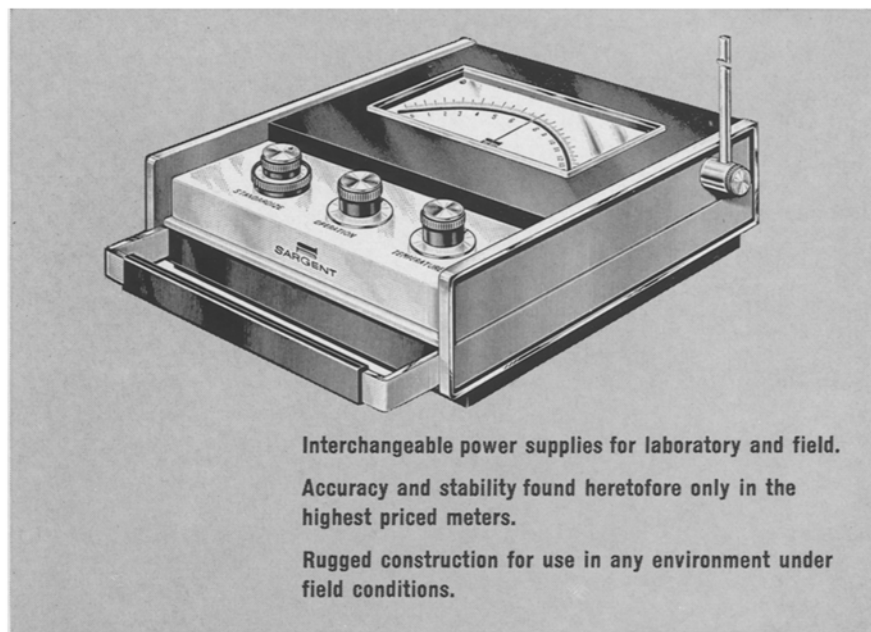
