## Chemistry Core Outlined for Technicians

The ACS Ad Hoc Technician Curriculum Committee has prepared a basic chemistry curriculum suitable for modifying established programs of technician training and for the development of new programs. Appointed by the American Chemical Society Board of Directors in 1966, the committee, under the chairmanship of Carleton Roberts of Dow, has since concentrated on the chemistry core of 28-30 units proposed by the earlier Ad Hoc Committee to Study Technician Training. An earlier report, the Young report, suggested a 68-72 unit, two-year curriculum in chemical technology.

To facilitate its work the Roberts Committee desires reaction to its proposed chemistry curriculum, printed in Chemical and Engineering News, Volume 45, May 22, 1967, pages 44-67.

The Committee hopes these recommendations will stimulate innovation toward more effective education of chemical technicians. Write to Education Office, American Chemical Society, 1155 Sixteenth St., N. W., Washington, D. C. 20036.
