

Durkee Scientists Cited for Dwight P. Joyce Award

Three scientists of the Glidden-Durkee Division of SCM Corporation (two of whom are with the Organic Chemicals Group in Jacksonville, Florida) just received the Division's highest award for scientific and technical achievements. The Dwight P. Joyce Award, presented annually to a selected few employees throughout the 9000 employees of Glidden-Durkee Division, was presented for this year in Cleveland, Ohio, on Dec. 12, 1967.

The three receiving the 1967 Dwight P. Joyce Award were Carl Bordenca (1965), Director of Research and Development, Organic Chemicals Group; Dr. John M. Derfer, Manager of Exploratory Research, also from the company's Jacksonville unit; and P. E. Pierce, Assistant Manager—Fundamental Research for Glidden-Durkee's Coatings and Resins Group in Cleveland, Ohio. The award is named for Glidden-Durkee's retired Chairman, Dwight P. Joyce.

Dr. Bordenca was cited for work which has recently led to the development of an entirely new class of bioactive compounds for the most part based on terpenes. Dr. Derfer was recognized for his contribution in terpene chemistry which has led to an important new chemical conversion process vital to the production of a wide range of organic chemicals.



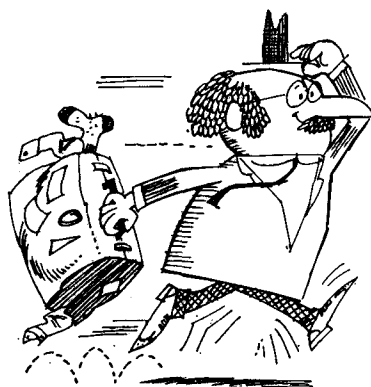
