#### Emeritus Member Samuel Belden Dies at 73

Sam Belden (1921) died January 11 in a local hospital following a sudden illness. Funeral services were held in the First Presbyterian Church, Fresno, January 12.

The members of the Northern California Section will miss Sam. He has been a friendly, active member of the Section for many years, having joined the Society in 1921. At the time of his death he was an emeritus member.

On Dec. 31, 1967 he retired from Ranchers Cotton Oil Company where he had held the position of chemical engineer for the past six years. Earlier, he had been Chief Chemist for the Producers Cotton Oil Company. Before coming to Fresno, Sam also held the position of chief chemist with the San Joaquin Cotton Oil Company in Chowchilla and chemist with the California Cotton Oil Company in Los Angeles.

Sam was born in Cucamonga, California, and lived in Fresno for 38 years, traveling to the San Francisco area for the Northern Section meetings.

He was a former president of the Fresno Council of Churches, and in addition to his AOCS activities, was an active member of the National Association of Professional Engineers.

His survivors include his wife Mary, a daughter, Mrs. Harry Begg of San Diego, and three grandchildren.

T. H. Smouse

T. H. Smouse, Research Chemist at the Anderson, Clayton Foods Division in Dallas, Texas, was the speaker at the Northeast Regional AOCS Meeting, Feb. 6, 1968.

Dr. Smouse spoke on the subject of soyhean oil reversion, a problem well known to those in the oil and food industries. He described numerous investigations that have been made throughout the world in analyzing the source of the off-flavor. Recent progress in eliminating off-flavor was evaluated, as well as methods contemplated for future use in combating the problem.

The studies Dr. Smouse has made in this field began in 1961 at Rutgers, The State University, where he did research on reversion of soybean oil under the direction of S. S. Chang, Professor of Food Chemistry, Department of Food Science. After receiving an MS in 1964 and a PhD in 1965, Dr. Smouse joined the Campbell Soup Company at their Institute for Food Research. Recently he became a Texan, when he was appointed head of the Flavor Chemistry Laboratory at Anderson, Clayton's new W. L. Clayton Research Center.


# Biochemistry of Lipids Conference in England
