His research is particularly significant because it was done in a short time and in an uncharted area where guidelines are lacking. This research requires unusual proficiency in organic chemistry and a high degree of expertise in mathematics, physical chemistry, electronics, and analog and digital computers. His work is a key factor in developing new catalysts for selective hydrogena-

tion of soybean oil to give improved flavor stability. Mr. Butterfield joined USDA's Northern Utilization Research and Development Division in 1960 as a student trainee while attending Bradley University, Peoria. He later earned an M.S. degree from the University of Illinois. He is a native of Peoria and resides at 1729 Willow Wood Drive.
