C. Y. Hopkins (1955) will be honored on June 22, 1968, on the occasion of his retirement from the National

Research Council, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada.

Dr. Hopkins joined the National Research Council in 1930, and currently serves as Head of the Fats and Oils Section, Division of Pure Chemistry. He is well known to the AOCS for his fundamental research on the structural analysis of lipids, fatty acids in particular. He has published numerous papers on the composition of seed

He received an MS degree from Queen's University in 1926 and a PhD from New York University in 1929. From 1929-1930 he was an instructor at the University of Toronto, and then joined the National Research Council
