# Conference on Surface Chemistry With Application to Cosmetic Science

The Society of Cosmetic Chemists and Columbia University College of Pharmaceutical Sciences will jointly sponsor the first Educational Conference on Cosmetic Science from November 2 to 7, 1969. The conference will be conducted at Columbia's Arden House, the former estate of the Harriman family. The program will treat "Surface Chemistry with Application to Cosmetic Science."

The Conference has been especially designed for scientists whose heavy schedules have prevented them from adequately keeping abreast of the most recent developments in emulsion and suspension theory and technology. The topics have been selected to expose scientists who graduated more than five years ago to concepts that were not taught in

colleges at that time.

Participants in the Conference will live at Arden House, Harriman, New York, thus providing them with ample opportunity for engaging in stimulating discussions with the faculty and other participants. In the morning sessions, faculty members will lecture for approximately 3 hours. Afternoons will be devoted to independent study and individual problem assignments. Panel discussions led by the Conference Chairman or faculty members will be held in the evenings.

The following topics will be discussed: Basic Surface Science, R. E. Johnson, Jr., E. I. du Pont de Nemours, Wilmington, Delaware; Colloid Stability, H. van Olphen, National Academy of Sciences, National Research Council, Washington, D.C.; Physical Chemistry of Surfactants, Morton Rosoff, College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Columbia University, New York City; Measurements in Surface Chemistry, J. C. Boylan, Eli Lilly and Co., Indianapolis,
