AOCS Treasurer's Report—April 1969

Annual Business Meeting-San Francisco

In 1968 the AOCS had a combined gross income of \$392,786.04, and total expenses amounting to \$408,633.41. This meant an operating deficit of \$15,877.37.

Increased publication expenses were primarily respon-sible for the deficit. The Journal operated at a loss of \$22,500, Lipids at a loss of \$11,000. The 1968 budget accurately reflected publishers increases resulting from higher labor and material costs. The budget could not reflect the increased number of pages (approximately 350) published during the year in the journals because of the Society's policy of publishing all manuscripts submitted and approved by the Editorial Board.

Production costs and the number of pages published will continue to increase in succeeding years. For these reasons the Executive Committee is recommending to the Governing Board that membership dues and nonmember subscription rates be increased effective January 1, 1970.

This recommendation, if approved, will make it possible to operate on a balanced budget in 1970. No additional revenue is available for operating expenses in 1969 and another deficit, estimated at \$25,700, is expected.

As an aid to future planning, the Ways and Means Committee, with the assistance of the Finance Committee, has prepared a 5 year forecast of the Society's financial needs. This information will enable the Finance Committee to accurately predict operating revenues for a minimum of two years ahead. More importantly, it makes possible recommendations to the Governing Board for additional sources of revenue sufficiently in advance of needs to operate the Society in a balanced financial condition.

Despite the deficit for this year, the Society remains in a sound financial condition with reserves of \$133,084 and assets of \$260,716 as of December 31, 1968.
