VI IFSCC Congress Barcelona 20-25 September 1970

The Spanish Society of Cosmetic Chemists, organizers of the IFSCC Congress which will be held in Barcelona from the 20th to the 25th of September 1970, extends an invitation to all those who may be interested, to presented original, unpublished, scientific papers.

These papers must deal with the following subjects, pertaining to the scientific program of the Congress: Color in Cosmetics, Physical-Chemical in Cosmetics, Biochemistry and Dermatology in Cosmetics, Practical Science of Cosmetics and Cosmetic Regulations and the Standardization of Raw Materials.

The IFSCC has given a prize of \$1,000 to be awarded by an International Jury for the best paper presented at the Congress.

Third Annual Coulter Particle Characteristics Course Scheduled for September

The third annual Particle Characteristics Course sponsored, as in the past, by Coulter Electronics Industrial Division will be held in San Francisco September 22-24, 1969, and in New York September 29-30 and October 1, 1969. Once again, internationally known lecturers from the Chemical Engineering Department of the University of Technology, Loughborough, England, along with guest lecturers from the United States will conduct courses.

Emphasis of this year's conference will center on par-

ticle behavior, interactions and instrumentation. In addition to talks on particle size, surface area, porosity and moisture, lectures will encompass sampling, packed beds, powder flow, classifications, physics of disperse systems and others.

To permit sufficient time for discussion, each course has been limited to a specific number of people. The \$92.00 per person fee includes lunches for all three days.
