ISA Silver Jubilee Conference and Exhibit

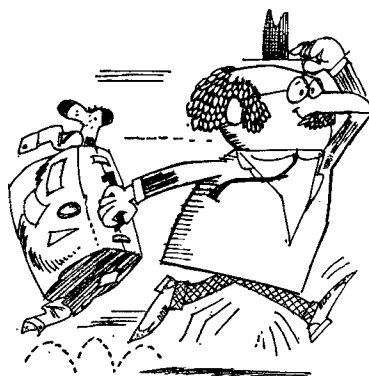
Short Course on Chemical Engineering Economics
