

## Nominations Invited for the 1971 AOAC Harvey W. Wiley Award for Analytical Contributions

The Association of Official Analytical Chemists invites nominations for the 15th AOAC Harvey W. Wiley Award for outstanding contributions to analytical chemistry. Nominees must be from North America but need not be AOAC members to be considered for the award.

The Harvey W. Wiley Award for analytical contributions was established by the AOAC in 1956 in honor of the father of the original Pure Food and Drug Law. Dr. Wiley was also one of the founders of the Association. The purpose of the award is to recognize an outstanding scientist or scientific team for contributions and achievements made in analytical methodology in subject areas of interest to agriculture and public health. Subjects include drugs, foods, beverages, colors, cosmetics, feeds, fertilizers, pesticides, vitamins, water and air pollution, and general analytical chemistry.

Nomination forms for the Wiley Award and further information may be obtained from L. G. Ensminger, Association of Official Analytical Chemists, Box 540, Benjamin Franklin Station, Washington, D.C. 20044. Nominations must be received by April 1, 1971, to be considered for the 1971 award. Any nominations submitted may be held four years for judging before renewal is necessary.

## Proceedings of the International Sunflower Conference

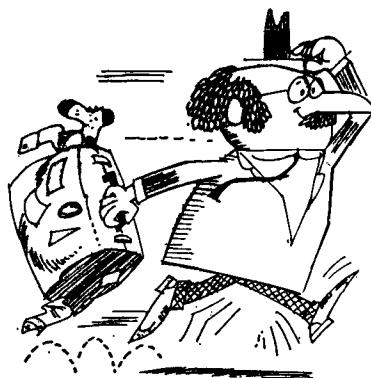
