



Outstanding Symposia Will Highlight Fall Meeting

Several outstanding health-related symposia will be featured on the technical program of the AOCs 45th Fall Meeting in Atlantic City, October 3-6. Papers will be delivered by internationally recognized authorities from the United States and foreign countries.

Hans Kaunitz, Professor of Biochemistry, Department of Pathology, College of Physicians and Surgeons, Columbia University, will chair a symposium on the "Nutritional Properties of Edible Fats."

Werner Fekl, technical director of J. Pfrimmer & Co., Erlangen, West Germany, will chair a symposium on "Biochemical and Clinical Aspects of the Use of Fat Emulsions in Parenteral Nutrition." Eight speakers from the United States and foreign countries will be featured on this symposium.
