G. William Miller, Textron president, has announced the appointment of George O'Hare as president of Textron's Spencer Kellogg Div.

O'Hare has been president of Patterson-Sargent, another Textron unit, since it became part of Textron in 1962. At Spencer Kellogg he will succeed AOCS member Robert L. Terrill, who has been reassigned to the Textron corporate office.

O'Hare will bring to Spencer Kellogg experience in research, manufacturing and marketing of chemical products in the oilseed and synthetic resins field. He has been associated with the resilient floor covering and coatings industry for many years and, prior to becoming president of Patterson-Sargent, held executive positions with Congoleum-Nairn, Inc.
