

Entertainment set for Chicago meeting

Plans are nearing completion for the AOCS 47th Annual Fall Meeting, to be held at the Pick Congress Hotel in Chicago, September 16-19. Entertainment Chairman Bart Greenwell has arranged the performance of several versatile musical groups at Tuesday evening's banquet, the major social event of the primarily technical meeting.

The Keller Trio, an instrumental and vocal group featuring piano, guitar, bass and accordeon, will entertain during dinner. Following their performance, Franz Benteler and the Royal Violins will present their act, featuring Benteler on his \$100,000 Stradivarius. This group is currently starring in the Consort Room of the Continental Plaza Hotel and prior to their appearance before the Society will have made a new recording in Austria. The Arbors, two pair of brothers including one pair of twins, are next on the bill. The style of this dynamic vocal quartet, accompanied by a trio, represents a whole range of musical moods from softly nostalgic to boldly symphonic. The evening's entertainment will be capped by dancing 'til midnight to the tune of a nine-piece band.
