AOCS members will convene September 16-19 in the Pick Congress Hotel, Chicago, for their 47th Annual Fall Meeting. Registration will be conducted on the convention floor from 1:00-6:00 P.M., Sunday.

Monique Quick, Ladies' Program Committee chairwoman, has announced that guests of Society members will be greeted in the "Welcome-to-Chicago Room," where they will find information on where to shop, dine and tour in the city, as well as ample warmth and hospitality.

On the agenda for Monday's Ladies' Program: After a continental breakfast, a tailor-made tour of Chicago, including her still-thriving ethnic neighborhoods; the new Sears building-the world's tallest; the John Hancock building; the new marble-covered Standard Oil building; the 50 foot Picasso sculpture; the plaza sites for the Marc Chagall ceramic murals and the Calder stabile; and, enroute, a description of Carl Sandburg's "City of big shoulders." Gaylord's [India] Restaurant will serve luncheon-a Far Eastern Indian repast complete with the host's description of this culture. The following visit to the Chicago Historical Society will include a viewing of the new "Great Lady Gowns" exhibit-28 historic gowns dating from the late 18th century to the present, with inaugural and formal garments worn by presidential wives from Mary Todd Lincoln to Pat Nixon.

Tuesday's events will include a complete, midmorning breakfast in the Private Dining Room of the Art Institute of Chicago, followed by a slide lecture and a tour of the Winslow Homer exhibit.

On Wednesday morning program participants will meet for continental breakfast and a choice of activities, including a tour of the expansive Chicago Central Water Filtration Plant.
