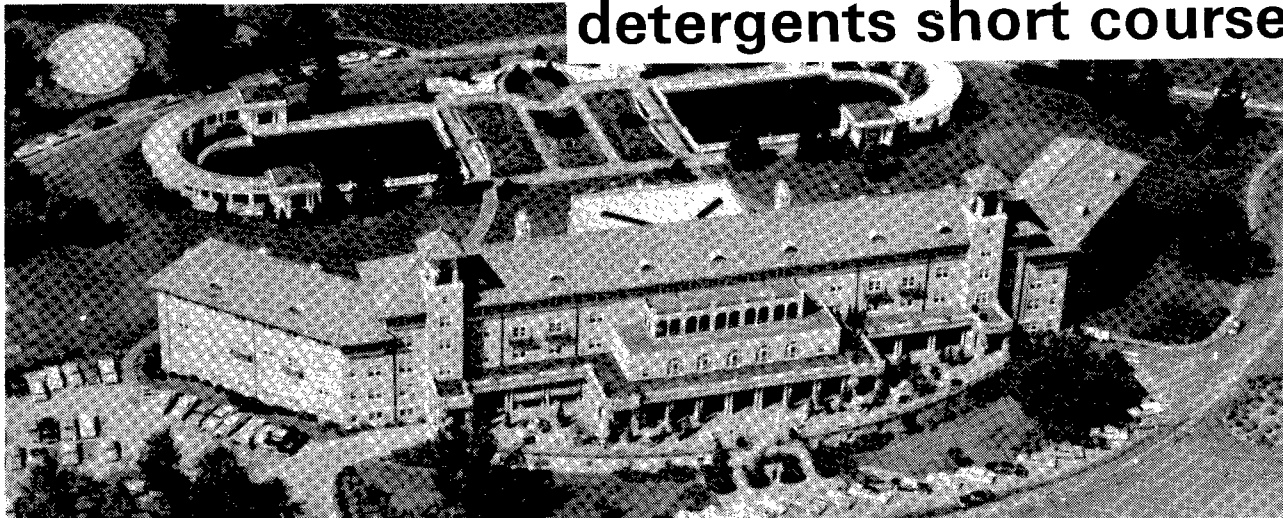


Topics announced for **detergents short course**

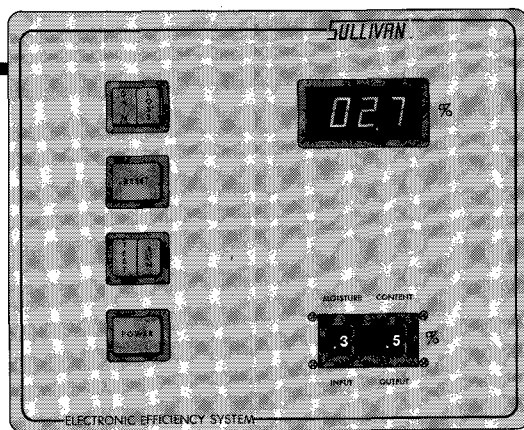

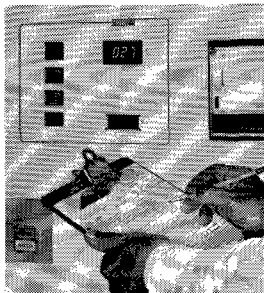
Fees, program chairmen, speakers, and other details will be announced in future issues of the *Journal*.
