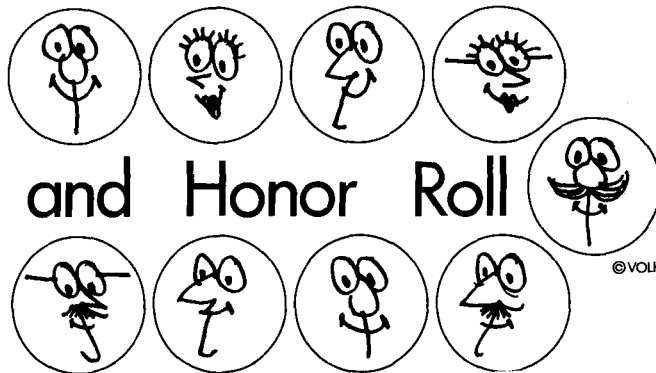




President's Club and Honor Roll

H.K. Mangold appointed head of Center for Lipid Research

JAOCs "Four Corners" correspondent H.K. Mangold has been appointed head of the Federal Center for Lipid Research, Münster, Germany.

Mangold had been executive director of the Institute for Biochemistry and Technology, H.P. Kaufmann Institute

since 1970.

Before returning to his native country, he was professor of biochemistry at the University of Minnesota and section leader at The Hormel Institute.

He is a member of the editorial boards of *Chemistry and Physics of Lipids*, *Journal of Lipid Research*, *Nutrition and Metabolism*, *Journal of Chromatographic Science*, and *Separation Science*. ■
