

Kass featured in Ladies' Night program

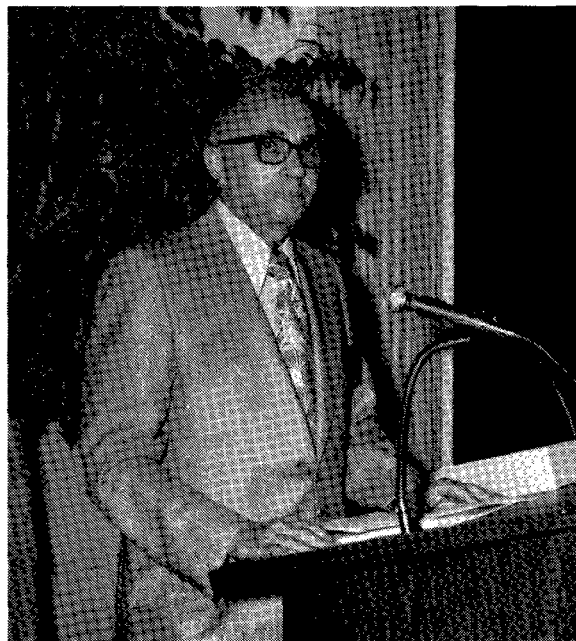
The North Central Section's Annual Ladies' Night, the final meeting of the year, was highlighted by a discussion of the cosmetics industry.

In his presentation entitled, "Cosmetics: Concepts, Chemistry, and Controversies," Gus Kass of G.S. Kass and Associates traced the origins of this prospering industry to chemical discoveries in such diverse fields as food, detergents, and photography.

Present outcries from environmentalists have resulted in the passage of laws which place restrictions on various products, he explained. Some of these laws are of course good, but, he added, others are based upon unproven hypotheses and misconceptions.

Kass concluded by stating that, given the present climate, the next few years will bring safer, more efficient cosmetic products with no real breakthroughs.
