

Annual Achievement Award Presented to Monick

On September 14, 1976, the Northeast Section of the American Oil Chemists' Society will present John Monick with their Annual Achievement Award. At the Awards Banquet, Monick will speak on the subject, "Industrial Research—What Is It?"

Monick has been employed by the Colgate-Palmolive Company for 38 years in various research and development areas. He is a research associate and was formerly head of Organic Chemical Development. He received a PhD in engineering science from New York University in 1955. He has since completed nine publications, including a recent book entitled Alcohols, and holds a dozen patents in the areas of detergents, fuels, and various mixing and drying processes.
