
Last chance to register for World Conference



U.S. residents planning to attend the World Conference on Vegetable Food Proteins are urged to mail their registrations forms as quickly as possible, if they have not already been mailed.

Registrations made after Oct. 1, 1978, carry a fee of 725 guilders; the fee for those received before Oct. 1 is 675 guilders. Housing and travel arrangments also must be co-ordinated.

Registration at the RAI Convention Center in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, will open at 1:30 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 29. The exposition portion of the conference will open at 4 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 29. Technical plenary programs begin at 9 a.m. Monday, Oct. 30. Exhibits will be open during an extended lunch hour Monday through Thursday. Round table discussion groups will be held each afternoon Monday through Friday.

The American Oil Chemists' Society will help arrange group travel plans from the United States to the Oil Technologists' Association of India's International Congress on Oilseeds and Oils to be held Feb. 9-13, 1979, in New Delhi.

A minimum of 15 persons is required for Air India to permit a group fare of \$854 to and from the conference. Persons in other nations should contact their local Air India office for sponsors of group travel. The DGF is arranging group gravel from Germany.

Symposia subjects are to include oilseed agronomy, new sources of fats and oils, stability; quality control, biosynthesis, metabolism, nutrition, toxicology, process technology, product development and others.
