Calvin to receive Gold Medal

Dr. Melvin Calvin, Nobel laureate in chemistry, has been named to receive the 1979 Gold Medal of the American Institute of Chemists. Dr. Calvin, University Professor of chemistry at the Berkeley campus, University of California, has gained international renown for his studies into the physical and chemical properties of photosynthesis. He will receive the Gold Medal at a meeting next May in Philadelphia. ●
