Committee Spotlights

Publications Committee

The Publications Committee is a constitutional committee responsible for supervision of all of the Society's publications, except those of the Uniform Methods Committee. It is comprised of the Chairman (appointed by the Governing Board), Editors of publications, and nine other appointed members, who serve on a three-year rotating basis.

The Publications Committee objectives are to establish policy and to direct the preparation and distribution of all AOCS publications, except those supervised by the Uniform Methods Committee, and to do it in such a way as to bring credit to the Society. To accomplish these things, several editorial subcommittees have been formed:

Over 100 people work in this system of subcommittees under the direction of the Publications Committee.

At present, 15 Associate Editors handle the editorial work of reviewing manuscripts submitted for publication in JAOCS, along with more than 100 reviewers who help review the manuscripts. These activities are coordinated by the Editor and his Editorial Assistant from the Editor's office in Minneapolis.

A group of 24 Associate Editors handles the editorial work of reviewing manuscripts submitted for publication in Lipids, along with a number of reviewers who help review the manuscripts. These activities are coordinated by the Editor and his Editorial Assistant from the Editor's office in Austin, Minnesota.

After manuscripts are reviewed and approved, they are forwarded to the AOCS office in Champaign, IL, for publi-

As of Jan. 1, 1978, under the new copyright laws, it is necessary for AOCS journals to secure specific grants of copyrights from authors of manuscripts submitted for publication.

In 1977, a total of 228 manuscripts was received and 200 forwarded to Champaign for publication in JAOCS. A total of 249 manuscripts was received and 140 forwarded to Champaign for publication in Lipids.

Only one monograph was printed in 1977, which was entitled "Polyunsaturated Fatty Acids."

In October 1977, the AOCS sponsored a World Conference on Soaps and Detergents in Montreux, Switzerland. The complete text of all papers presented (approximately 50) was published in the January 1978 issue of JAOCS. As a result of the Montreux meeting and a desire by the attending participants for more scientific and technological information and greater activity in this discipline, a special Soaps, Detergents, and Cosmetics Section appears monthly, beginning with the February 1978 issue of JAOCS. Papers in this section are reviewed just as all other JAOCS technical papers.
