AOCS to cosponsor New Delhi meeting


The American Oil Chemists' Society has become a cosponsor for the International Congress on Oilseeds and Oils to be held Feb. 9-13, 1979, in New Delhi, India, under the organization of the Oil Technologists' Association of India.

AOCS participation as a cosponsor was approved by the AOCS Executive Committee during its meeting during August in Champaign.

The scientific portion of the congress will consist of plenary lectures, a number of technical symposia on production and processing, as well as a technical exhibition. Organizers also are planning visits by delegates to research and industrial institutions near New Delhi and elsewhere in India.

Symposia subjects listed thus far are: oilseed agronomy, new sources of fats and oils; stability of fats and oils; quality control; biosynthesis, metabolism, and nutrition; toxicology; process technology and product development; and appropriate technology for developing countries.
