Soybean meeting March 26-29, 1979

World Soybean Research Conference II will be held March 26-29, 1979, at the North Carolina State University, Raleigh, NC.

The follow-up to a similar conference held a few years ago, the new meeting aims at providing a forum for presentation and discussion of recent advances in soybean production, marketing and utilization research. Concurrent session topics include plant pathology; engineering; nitrogen fixing; entomology; utilization (oil), utilization (protein); breeding; mineral nutrition; modeling soybean systems; marketing, transportation and storage; physiology; and weed control, plus plenary sessions each morning.
