

ISF/AOCS World Congress



Deadline for abstracts— NOVEMBER 15

Persons who wish to present a paper at the ISF/AOCS World Congress next spring have until Nov. 15, 1979, to submit an abstract to Dr. Stephen S. Chang; Technical Program Chairman; ISF/AOCS World Congress; Department of Food Science; Rutgers, The State University; PO Box 231; New Brunswick, NJ 08903.

Authors should submit three copies of a 100- to 300-word abstract, including title, authors and speaker. Presentations normally are 20 minutes in length. Authors may present papers in the normal "lecture" format or during a "poster session." In poster sessions, authors post their data on bulletin boards and talk informally with visitors.

The meeting will be held April 27-May 1, 1980, at the New York Hilton at Rockefeller Center, New York City. The event will be the 71st Annual Meeting of the AOCS and the 15th World Congress of the International Society for Fat Research (ISF).

Serving as cochairman for the technical program committee is Ragnar J.S. Ohlson of AB Karlshamns Oljefabriker in Karlshamn, Sweden. After all abstracts have been received, Dr. Chang, Dr. Ohlson and the technical program committee will organize the schedule for the technical program. Between 300 and 400 papers are expected to be presented. Approximately 80 top-ranking specialists in the United States and Europe are serving as convenors and coconvenors for the Congress, soliciting papers on all phases of fats and oils and lipids. A full schedule of symposia and technical sessions will be announced early next year.

Special travel arrangements are being made for Europeans who plan to attend the Congress.

The AOCS will sponsor two short courses, "Fats and Oils Processing" and "Applications of Analytical Methodology to Fats and Oils Processing", the week before the World Congress. The Golden Jubilee International Congress on "Essential Fatty Acids and Prostaglandins" will be held May 4-7, 1980, at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, MN. Details will be available from Dr. Ralph Holman, Director, The Hormel Institute; University of Minnesota, Austin, Minnesota, 55912 USA.

Arrangements also are being made for short visits to institutions in the New York City area. On Sunday, April 27, European registrants will be invited by Dr. Chang to

tour the Department of Food Science at Rutgers. Buses will depart and return from the headquarters hotel.

Registration and housing reserving information will be available early next year from the AOCS, 508 S. Sixth St., Champaign, IL 61820 USA. ●
