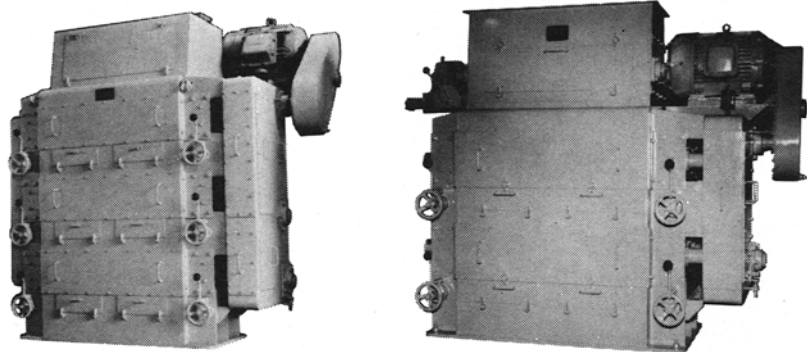
Margarine program in Paris

"Information Day: Margarine" will be held Dec. 17-18, 1979, in Paris under sponsorship of the L'Institut des Corps Gras and the Chambre Syndicate de la Margarine—Trade Union Committee for Margarine Producers.
