DGF meeting in September

The Deutsche Gesselschaft für Fettwissenschaft (DGF) will sponsor a general symposium on the "Science of Fatty Materials" to be held Sept. 24-28, 1979, at the Technical University of Vienna, Austria.

Topics to be discussed include sunflowers and soybeans as oil protein sources; new lipoprotein research; lipids of the skin surface; analysis and uniform methods; fats as food substances; proteins as fatty raw materials; lipids in personal care products; paints; waxes; biological and clinical chemistry of lipids; ecology, environmental protection and occupation safety; procedural technology; and fats and oilseeds for feed.

The annual presentation of the Normann Medal will be Sept. 26. A postmeeting visit to Budapest, including sunflower crop areas, will follow the meeting.
