April 27-May 1, 1980



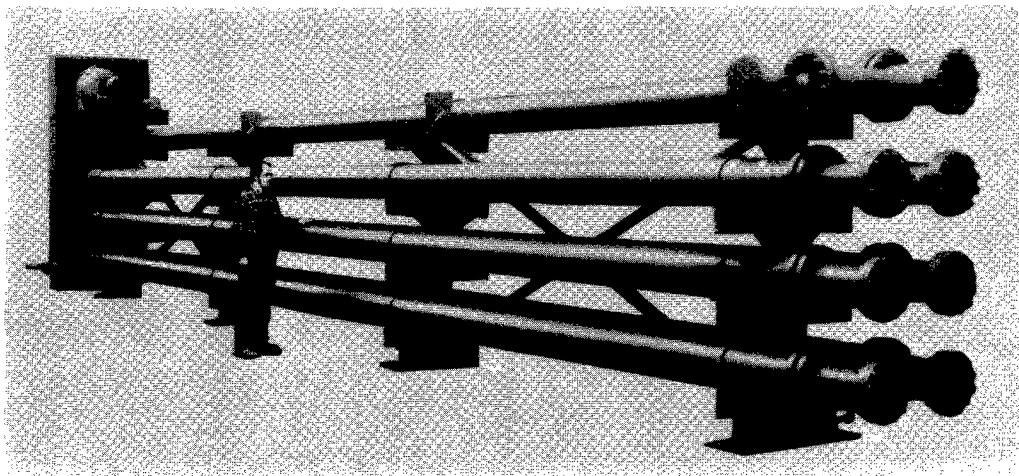
Headquarters hotel for the ISF/AOCS World Congress to be held April 27-May 1, 1980, in New York City will be the New York Hilton at Rockefeller Center, the largest hotel in New York.

The World Congress will require approximately half of the hotel's 2,000 guest rooms, which occupy the top 42 floors of the 46-story hotel.

The hotel is at mid-town Manhattan, on the Avenue of the Americas between 53rd and 54th streets. It is near Broadway's theater district, one block from Fifth Avenue's famed shopping district, and close to many of the city's famed cultural centers.

The hotel contains four restaurants, including Sybil's, whose indoor waterfall over a greenhouse has led to its being described as the most beautiful discotheque in New York. Meeting, banquet and exhibit rooms are located on the second and third floors, which are accessible from the lobby by escalator or elevator. Shops and restaurants are on the lobby level and lower promenade.
