## Erdman receives IFT award

John W. Erdman, an AOCS member since 1978, received the IFT's 1980 Samuel Cate Prescott Award earlier this year. The award, presented annually to a research scientist under 36 years of age, consists of a \$1,000 honorarium and a plaque.

Erdman is an assistant professor of food science at the University of Illinois where he has been a faculty member since receiving his doctorate from Rutgers in 1975. Much of his applied research has been on the nutritional quality of soy protein foods. Erdman developed a method to produce full-fat soy flour to be used in bread to improve the bread's protein quality. He is principal investigator on a USDA grant to study the effects of processing on the bio-availability of zinc, magnesium, calcium and iron from soy products. □
