Fats, oils meeting in New Zealand

An International Conference on the Chemistry, Biochemistry and Technology of Fats and Oils, sponsored by the Royal Society of New Zealand, has been announced for Feb. 6-9, 1983, in Auckland, New Zealand.

Details will be available from the conference chairman, S.G. Brooker, c/o Chemistry Department, The University of Auckland, Private Bag, Auckland, New Zealand. Brooker is an emeritus member of AOCS.

"February comes in the New Zealand summer, and is an excellent time for those who would like to see the unique scenic features of the country as well as meeting chemists in their own field," Brooker said in a letter announcing the conference. "This could be the first conference on fats and oils chemistry in the Southern Hemisphere and therefore a unique event in the history of our branch of science and technology."

An international symposium on the "Food Industry and the Environment" will be held during September 1982 under auspices of the Hungarian Scientific Society of Food.

Topics will include large agro-industrial concerns, development of waste-free technologies for specific sections of the food industry, water and soil pollution, air pollution, and noise problems.




