NCPA safety report

The National Cottonseed Products Association has issued its publication "Emergency Procedures and General Safety Guidelines for Solvent Extraction Plants."

NCPA emphasized the report contains "very general" guidelines to provide a foundation from which an individual facility can develop a safety program tailored to its equipment and situation. Topics include safety procedures to avoid emergencies, emergency plant shutdowns, purging recommendations, how to purge, startup after shutdown, general safety guidelines and management responsibility for fire safety.

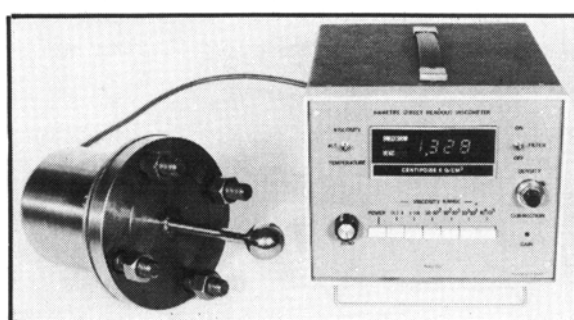
