

Governing Board sets AOCS mission

Meeting in Phoenix, Arizona, during May in conjunction with the AOCS annual meeting, the AOCS Governing Board approved a mission statement for the society and discussed changing membership requirements.

The mission statement for AOCS adopted by the board is as follows: "To be a forum for the exchange of ideas, information, and experience among those with a professional interest in the science and technology of fats, oils, and related substances in ways that promote personal excellence and provide for high standard of quality."

Also, the board discussed revising educational and experience requirements for active membership in the society. The question of opening active membership to a broader audience was referred by the board to an ad hoc committee. The ad hoc committee also will consider the implications of such a change on the AOCS Articles of Incorporation and By-laws. AOCS President Timothy Mounts appointed Roy Carr chairperson and E.G. Perkins and Robert Hastert members of the ad hoc committee.

On a recommendation from the Marketing Task Force, the Governing Board established a Marketing Oversight Committee and a Professional Relations Committee and dissolved the Public Relations, International Development and International Relations committees. The Marketing Oversight Committee will be a monitoring group while the Professional Relations Committee, established under the Membership Coordinating Committee, will be an action committee. Robert Hastert will chair the Marketing Oversight Committee; A.R. Baldwin will chair the Professional Relations Committee.

Reporting for the Financial Coordinating Committee, AOCS Treasurer Robert Burton noted that the society's investments are slightly over \$350,000, but still below the pre-October 1987 market-drop level. The committee's goal is to rebuild society reserves as quickly as possible.

Chairpersons for coordinating committees appointed by Mounts and approved by the board are E.G. Perkins, Education Activities Coordinating Committee; Randall Wood, Publications Activities Coordinating Committee; and John Heilman, Technical Activities Coordinating Committee. Vice chairpersons appointed for the activity coordinating committees are Joseph Endres, Membership; David Tandy, Financial; Pamela White, Education; Edward Campbell, Publications; and Edmund Lusas, Technical.

Membership

Roy Carr reported that Cargill Inc. has offered a \$2,000 per year honorarium for 10 years to fund the A.R. Baldwin Distinguished Service Award, in addition to paid travel expenses for the awardee to attend the AOCS annual meeting. Board members, however, noted that the award is not necessarily given out annually. The board accepted the offer from Cargill and authorized Carr to negotiate with Cargill for the award to remain an occasional award based on merit.

Also, the board tabled a proposal to establish an endowment fund for the Honored Student Program.

In another membership-related matter, the board directed the Membership Admissions Committee to review emeritus membership requirements.

Technical

The board appointed John Callahan to fill the vacancy on the Uniform Methods Committee left by William Link. The board also discussed the proposed new format for the revised methods book scheduled for release in late 1989. The board gave the Technical Coordinating Committee responsibility for pricing the revised methods book.

The board discussed the increasing work load of the AOCS technical director. AOCS Executive Director Jim Lyon noted that much

of the technical director's time is spent answering technical questions and suggested the board consider whether this is how staff resources should be used.

Education

E.G. Perkins reported on world conferences proposed by the World Conference Planning Committee. These include a processing meeting in Latin America in 1991, a processing meeting in Hungary or another Eastern European country in 1992, a surfactants meeting in Asia in 1993 and a processing meeting in China in 1994. He also discussed the status of the 1988 protein conference slated for Singapore, the 1989 processing conference in The Netherlands and the 1990 oleochemical conference in Malaysia.

The board approved Anaheim, California, as the location for the 1993 AOCS annual meeting. Sites considered for 1994 include San Antonio, Texas; Atlanta, Georgia; St. Louis, Missouri; and Memphis, Tennessee.

In other education matters, the board tabled a proposal to establish an AOCS lectureship.

In addition, the board voted to organize the Technical Interest Committee under the jurisdiction of the Education Coordinating Committee to promote technical interest discussion groups at the annual meeting.

In other action, the scope of the World Conference Planning Committee will be expanded to include oversight of the development of technical programs for world conferences.

Publications

In publications matters, the board authorized the acquisition of telefax equipment for the editors of *JAOCs* and *Lipids*, with the decision to purchase or lease based on cost.

Randall Wood, chairperson of the Publications Coordinating Committee (PCC), proposed that each AOCS journal editor provide a free

subscription to that journal to the associate editors of the other AOCS journal. The Governing Board said such a decision can be made by the PCC.

The board approved a Monograph Committee policy to reimburse registration fees of invited speakers, who otherwise could not attend AOCS annual meetings. Such reimbursement will be made only on receipt of their manuscripts and provided the symposium is approved for publication in advance by the Monograph Committee.

The board approved a royalty payment schedule for editors and authors of monographs. In addition, the board authorized the Monograph Committee to solicit a maximum of three titles per year from outside sources, with a flat fee paid for publications rights.

Administrative

Mike Pulliam, chairman of the Buildings and Grounds Committee, has resigned because of a job transfer. The Governing Board appointed Norman Field to replace him.

Robert Hastert noted that the 1988-89 Nominations and Election Committee plans to involve AOCS sections and chairpersons in the nominations process for AOCS of-

ficers and Governing Board members.

Sections

As reported in the July issue of *JAACS*, the Governing Board approved the formation of the Latin American and Memphis Sections of AOCS, provided the two groups fulfill necessary requirements.

The Committee on Program Evaluation recommended that the board continue to encourage the development of local and specialty sections and that AOCS sections be responsible for direct costs provided by the AOCS headquarters for such items as printing and postage. However, the committee suggested new sections receive an automatic two-year waiver from this requirement and that the policy not be enforced until current sections have adequate time to adjust to this policy. The board approved the recommendations, and directed the AOCS Secretary to notify the sections of this action.

Meetings

The Governing Board directed AOCS staff to set up a computer system to track paper presenters failing to meet commitments. This list will be available to organizers of future programs.

Arnold Gavin, general chairman for the 1988 annual meeting in Phoenix, said that meeting was a great success both technically and socially. The board congratulated Gavin and thanked him for his efforts in organizing the meeting.

Thomas Applewhite, chairman for the 1987 World Conference on Biotechnology held in Hamburg, in reported the meeting was a success scientifically. The Governing Board expressed its appreciation to Applewhite and his committee for their planning and work.

Executive Director Jim Lyon explained the role of the staff members present at the annual meeting and noted that staff are assigned to facilitate the work of committees at the meeting. The board expressed its appreciation for and confidence in staff efforts at AOCS meetings.

The board voted to present a proposed amendment on the authority of the Governing Board and the AOCS Foundation concerning indemnification to the membership at the 1989 annual business meeting in Cincinnati, Ohio.

The Governing Board will hold its next meeting Sept. 6-8, 1988, in Champaign, Illinois.

AOCS certifies 66 chemists

The AOCS Examination Board has certified 66 approved chemists working in 43 independent analytical laboratories, based on the chemists' participation in the AOCS Smalley Check Sample Program.

Applicants for the approved chemist designation must demonstrate proficiency using designated methods in fats, oils and oilseeds analysis on check samples distributed through the Smalley Program.

Laboratories are listed in alphabetical order. Each listing gives the laboratory name, address and telephone number; the name(s) of the approved chemist(s) at the laboratory and the categories in which the laboratory chemist(s) received certification.

Obituary

GEORGE M. KREUTZER

AOCS emeritus member George M. Kreutzer died May 28, 1988, of heart failure.

Mr. Kreutzer was employed by Anderson, Clayton and Co. in Houston, Texas, when he joined AOCS in 1952. During his career, he also worked for Swift & Co., in Chicago, Illinois; Libby McNeil & Co., in Chicago; Nestle Corp., in White Plains, New York; P.V.O. International, in San Francisco, California; and EMI Corp., in Des Plaines, Illinois. He retired in June 1983 from EMI Corp.

He earned his B.S. in mechanical engineering from the University of Cincinnati in 1941.

He served on such AOCS committees as communications, finance, meetings logistics, membership, nominating and election, program and planning, public relations, technical safety and engineering, national meeting program, national meeting committee, and publications. He was general chairman for the society's 1965 spring meeting in Houston, Texas.
