#### Information for Authors

The subject matter of *Perkin Transactions 1* embraces all aspects of organic and bio-organic chemistry. These include synthetic organic chemistry of all types, organometallic chemistry, chemistry and biosynthesis of natural products, the relationship between molecular structure and biological activity, the chemistry of polymers and biological macromolecules, and medicinal and agricultural chemistry where there is originality in the science.

*Perkin Transactions 2* deals with the physicochemical aspects of organic, organometallic and bio-organic chemistry including kinetic, mechanistic, structural, spectroscopic, and theoretical studies. Such topics include structure-activity relationships and physical aspects of biological processes and of the study of polymers and biological macromolecules.

All contributions are judged on the criteria of (i) originality and quality of scientific content and (ii) appropriateness of the length to the content of new science. Short papers are acceptable provided that they constitute full reports of completed pieces of work and are not fragments of more extensive studies. Preliminary accounts of novel and significant work of exceptional specialist interest, in any branch of organic chemistry, may be published as Communications in *Perkin Transactions 1* or 2 as appropriate.
