The extent and vigour of electrochemical research and education in India is well illustrated by the fact the *Bulletin of Electrochemistry*, published by that country's Central Electrochemical Research Institute (CECRI) is to move to monthly publication from 1988. First published in 1985, this periodical has become well established and contains papers of consistently good scientific quality. The Bulletin claims the distinctive feature that each issue includes at least one paper from all eight of its thematic divisions of Corrosion Science, Metal Finishing, Batteries, Electrochemi-

cals, Electrometallurgy, Electrochemical Materials Science, Electrodeics and Electrobiolgy and Electrochemical Instrumentation. The Bulletins are well produced with clear print and good layout.
