Carl Wagner Medal of Excellence

The second edition of the Carl Wagner Medal of Excellence in Electrochemical Engineering will be presented at the 6th European Symposium on Electrochemical Engineering, Düsseldorf, 16–18 September 2002. This medal is awarded by the Working Party on Electrochemical Engineering of the European Federation of Chemical Engineers. The competition is open to European researchers under the age of 35 years for outstanding contributions to research in applied electrochemistry or electrochemical engineering. The first edition of the medal was presented in 1999 to Dr Karel Bouzek of VSCHT, Prague.
