

SVERDLOVSK MEETING OF READERS OF "INZHENERNO-FIZICHESKII ZHURNAL"

This conference was held on February 4, 1975, in the Kirov Polytechnical Institute of the Urals; it was attended by representatives from research and teaching organizations in Sverdlovsk, Moscow, Leningrad, Kiev, Minsk, and other cities.

L. F. Timofeev, secretary to the editorial board, presented a report from the board for 1971-1974; he spoke of the major trends in the scientific topics handled by the journal, the type and volume of the work handled by the board, the international relationships of the journal, and the special issues concerned with particular topics.

Professor O. M. Todes, Corresponding Member of the Academy of Sciences of the Ukrainian SSR, K. E. Makhorin, Professor Yu. A. Buevich, Professor N. I. Syromyatnikov, Professor A. P. Baskakov, and others participated in the discussion of the journal; it was suggested that there should be more review articles, while some types of articles should be shortened, thereby increasing the information content of the journal. The discussion emphasized the increasing importance of the journal in the research activity in heat engineering and heat physics in research and teaching centers throughout the country.

On February 7, 1975, a conference of readers of the journal was held in the technical physics section of the Urals Scientific Center, Academy of Sciences of the USSR; this was attended by workers in the section.

The secretary to the board, L. F. Timofeev, presented a report on the work of the board.

During the discussion, topics considered included the times taken to publish articles, the rules for article formulation for deposition, the volumes of articles, and the balance between theoretical and experimental studies in the journal.
