

BOOK REVIEW

Organometallic Chemistry Reviews. Section B—Annual Surveys; Edited by D. SEYFERTH AND R. B. KING, Elsevier Sequoia, Lausanne. Vol. 4, No. 1, 1968. Annual Subscription rate \$19.80.

This is the first part of the three or four part volume of the Annual Surveys of Organometallic Chemistry covering 1967. The present issue has 159 pages, and covers the transition metals. [These Annual Surveys, previously published for 1964, 1965, and 1966 in book form (now regarded as Volumes 1-3) will appear in this journal form in future, which should enable more rapid publication of at least part of each survey than was previously possible.] The accounts are by R. B. King, except for those dealing with lanthanides, actinides, titanium, zirconium, hafnium, vanadium, niobium and tantalum, which are by F. Calderazzo. The high standard of previous years is maintained.

There is little doubt that there will be at least as much enthusiasm for the Annual Surveys in this new form as there was for the earlier books. No organometallic chemist can afford not to have the surveys available. Some free sample copies of the first issue are available from Elsevier Sequoia S.A., P.O. Box 851, Lausanne, Switzerland.
