FOURTH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON MULTIVARIATE ANALYSIS

The Fourth International Symposium on Multivariate Analysis will be held at Wright State University, Dayton, Ohio, during the period June 16–21, 1975. The symposium will be dedicated to the memory of the late Professors H. Hotelling and P. C. Mahalanobis. This symposium, as the earlier ones, is sponsored by the Aerospace Research Laboratories. Persons who have already either accepted invitations or indicated tentative acceptance to present papers at the symposium include Professors A. V. Balakrishnan, R. C. Bose, T. Hida, J. Kiefer, D. Middleton, C. R. Rao, M. Rosenblatt, Yu. A. Rozanov, and M. Siotani. It is expected that several other distinguished workers in the field from various countries will present invited papers on a broad spectrum of topics on the theory and applications of multivariate analysis. There will be sessions on contributed papers on theoretical aspects as well as applications. Attendance at the symposium is open to anyone interested.
