CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR ICTA AWARDS

The Dupont Award, consisting of a plaque, an honorarium of dollars 1000 and expenses to attend the conference is presented at each ICTA meeting to a recipient, who in the judgement of the Awards Committee and council of ICTA, best meets the following criteria.

The award is to be presented as a mark of distinction and recognition to a person who has:

- (a) made an outstanding contribution to the science of thermal analysis, and/or
- (b) shown significant leadership in and has made an outstanding contribution to the profession of thermal analysis.

A new ICTA award has been instituted to encourage young scientists to become involved with thermal analysis and to provide the opportunity for them to participate in ICTA by presenting results of their relevant work. The award will consist of a plaque to be presented to the recipient at the ICTA meeting together with the necessary financial support to attend the conference. Candidates must be less than 35 years of age as of december 31, 1985. Supporting documents must include the paper (in english) which they wish to present. The candidate should be the sole author of this work.

Nominations are sought for prospective candidates to receive these awards at the 8th ICTA in Bratislava, ČSSR, during August 19–23, 1985. Nominations are not held over from previous considerations. Nominations should include the consent of the candidate, curriculum vitae, list of publications and supporting letters or documentation.
