**CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR ICTA AWARD****TA Instruments (formerly DuPont ) Award**

This consists of a plaque, an honorarium of 1000 US \$, and expenses to attend the Hatfield meeting. It is awarded to a person who has, in the judgement of the Awards Committee and Council of ICTA, made an outstanding contribution to the science of thermal analysis and / or shown significant leadership to the profession of thermal analysis. Nominations should include the consent of the candidate, curriculum vitae, list of publications, and other relevant supporting material. Five copies of the nomination portfolio should be provided.

**Young Scientist Award**

This consists of a plaque and necessary financial support to attend the Hatfield meeting. Candidates, who must be under 35 years of age as of December 31, 1992, should submit the paper that they intend to present at the meeting, together with a list of publications and a short curriculum vitae. The paper must be in English and the candidate must be the sole author. Five copies of the documentation should be provided. Nominations for both Awards should be received by September 30, 1991 by
