

Visualized Analysis of Diesel Combustion Under the High Boosting Engine Condition




Fig. 1. Pressure curve and rate of heat release in diesel engine.




Fig. 2. High-speed photographs of diesel combustion (Pinj = 100 MPa, λ = 3.5, ε = 16, Ne = 1000 rpm).

Experimental results of High boosting combustion

The pressure diagrams and the rates of heat release are shown in Fig. 1, when the boost pressure increased. Figure 2 shows the combustion photographs under the conditions, which are approximately 3.5 times intake air of NA engine, the air excess ratio λ = 3.5 constant, the nozzle specification 0.17×6 and the injection pressure Pb=100MPa. The high boosting gives good combustion and high thermal efficiency. It is very difficult to take combustion photo in a diesel engine due to high cylinder pressure but we success in 15MPa such as high cylinder pressure.
