

## 2001 International Symposium on Wood and Pulping Chemistry Palais des Congrès, Nice, France June 11-14, 2001

The next International Symposium on Wood and Pulping Chemistry will be held June 11-14, 2001 at the Palais des Congrès in Nice, France. Sponsored by EUCEPA, TAPPI, PAPTAC, Chinese TAPPI, APPITA, Japan TAPPI, the Symposium will be organized by the French Association Technique de l'Industrie Papetière (ATIP). The Conference Chairman is François Vessière, President of EUCEPA and ATIP, Paris and the Program Chairman is Professor Dominique Lachenal of Ecole Française de Papeterie, Grenoble, France.

The program committee is seeking papers on recent research into wood and non-wood fibres, pulping, bleaching, recycling and papermaking chemistry. It will include the following topics:
