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**Special Three-Page Communications**

At a recent meeting, the *JACS* Editorial Advisory Board discussed the problem of a small number of communications that require extensive graphics to describe the work and thus cannot be accommodated with the two-page limit for Communications to the Editor. On the basis of this discussion, we have decided to accept, *for a limited number of papers that have this special requirement of extensive graphics*, three-page Communications. Communications that seek to use three pages merely for more extensive verbiage will not be considered for this exception. Three-page Communications must be prepared using one of the word processing templates available at [http://pubs.acs.org/journals/jacsat/jacs\\_inst.html](http://pubs.acs.org/journals/jacsat/jacs_inst.html) and must be preapproved by a *JACS* editor or associate editor before submission for peer-review (please note that no exceptions to these requirements will be allowed). We expect that most Communications will continue to be of the two-page form, which are very popular with the readership. Processing of these two- and three-page Communications will also be expedited if they are submitted electronically in the pdf format (see previous editorial: *J. Am. Chem. Soc.* **2000**, *122*, 1847).
