## Oil and Fat Export Tonnage Is on the Increase Although Values Decline

Fats from the United States for the month of October amounted to over 60 million pounds. These had a total value of nearly 9 million dollars. Exports of these products have increased slightly from what they were a year ago, although measured in dollars and cents they show a slight falling off as a result of the lower prices which they are commanding in for-

eign markets. For the first 10 months of 1925, exports of animal oil and fats totalled 720 million pounds as compared with 725 million this year. A year ago these products commanded an export price of 119 million dollars as against 110 million this year.

Statistics covering in detail the domestic export of oils and fats were reported by the Department of Commerce on Nov. 27 as follows:
