

Announce Exhibitors For Cincinnati Meeting in Fall

DREPARATIONS for the 26th annual fall meeting of the American Oil Chemists' Society are well under way, with N. A. Ruston of Emery Industries Inc. as general chairman. It will be held in Cincinnati, October 20-22, 1952 at the Netherland Plaza hotel. Registration will be from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on October 20 and 21, and tickets for special events may be obtained when registering.

The Netherland Plaza and the Terrace Plaza hotels have set aside 500 rooms for those attending the convention, and more rooms will be available if early reservations indicate that they are needed. Since however there are indications of a very large attendance, reservations should be made as soon as possible, direct with the hotels.

The two plant inspection trips are both scheduled for Tuesday, October 21, at 1:30 p.m.: Emery Industries Inc. or the new Miami Valley research laboratories of Procter and Gamble.

PROCTER THOMSON, ladies' chairman. writes the Journal as follows: "The Ladies' Entertainment Committee of the Cincinnati meeting cordially invites all of the chemists' ladies to visit with us in Cincinnati in October.
