

Short Course on Unit Processes Opens July 16

CINCE THE PROGRAM DETAILS were published in the June issue for the 1956 short course, another name has been announced: E. J. Healy, of Colgate-Palmolive Company, Jeffersonville, Ind., who will speak on the Handling and Storage of Raw Materials for Soaps and Detergents. The course will be given on Unit Processes in the Fatty Oil, Soap, and Detergent Industries at Purdue University, with F. W. Quackenbush, of Purdue, as local chairman, from July 16-20.

Sponsored by the Education Committee, of which K. F. Mattil, Swift and Company, Chicago, is chairman, the course will be the eighth conducted by the American Oil Chemists' Society. Proceedings will be published in the October and November 1956 issues of the Journal, and reprints will be available later.

Registration for the course will be \$50, payable in advance to the American Oil Chemists' Society, 35 E. Wacker drive, Chicago 1, Ill. Room and board will be available on a hotel basis, either at the Memorial Union or at a commercial hotel.

Room rates will be \$4 and up for single, \$6 and up for double, and \$7 and up for twin beds. Not all the Union rooms are air-conditioned. The meeting room in the Chemistry building, across the parking lot from the Union, will be air-conditioned however. Reservations for Union rooms should be made direct with Lloyd Vallely, manager.

Social events will include a banquet, for which tickets may be purchased on arrival at the campus.
