## Bond Award Established for Best Paper of Year

ANEW GOLD MEDAL AWARD, called the Bond Award, will be given the first time for the best paper presented at the 1958 fall meeting in Chicago. The primary purpose of the award is to stimulate greater interest in presenting papers before the American Oil Chemists' Society and in improving the over-all quality of the presentation and the manuscript.

A rotating Award Committee, consisting of three members appointed by the president of the Society, will establish the rules, choose the judges, and review the manuscripts. Evaluation of the papers during presentation will be made by a set of judges chosen by the committee.

Papers will be judged not only on presentation technique but also on their own merits. The rules are as follows:

## ORAL PRESENTATION-60 points

- 10 points for quality of subject matter including originality and scientific value
- 10 points for general organization of the talk
- 15 points for quality of slides and/or other visual aids
- 20 points for delivery: 5 points for clarity of speech, 2 points for grammar, 3 points for gestures and physical deportment, 5 points for ease of handling notes or manuscript, and 5 points for sincerity and persuasiveness
- 5 points for over-all quality of the abstract, as printed in the convention program

## PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPT-40 points

- 30 points for the over-all scientific merit of the paper, including originality, soundness of experimental design, validity of data, and logic of discussions and conclusions
- 10 points for conformity to the Journal style sheet, quality of tables and figures, and clarity

The paper with the highest number of points will merit the gold medal award, and the recipient will be the person who actually delivered it. Co-authors will be recognized by an award certificate. The gold medal will be presented to the winner at the Golden Anniversary Meeting to be held in New Orleans in April, 1959. The donor of this medal, who wishes to remain anonymous, is making sufficient financial provisions for perpetuating the Award.
